Frequently Asked Questions

What is included in Drivers Education?

- 30 hours of Classroom Instruction (must be at least 15 years, 9 months of age)
- 12 hours Behind-the-Wheel Instruction
- 6 hours of In-Car Observation time
- 2 hour Parent/Guardian Class, attended by at least one parent (certificate valid for 5 years)

How old must a student be to take Drivers Education?

15 years 9 months

Do you need a learner's permit before you start Drivers Education?

No. However, students must have their permit in hand for all in-car driving lessons.

When can a student obtain a learner's permit?

A student may obtain a learner's permit once they have reached age 16. Student will have to go to the Registry of Motor Vehicles, and bring a birth certificate, and Social Security card.

When can a student take in-car lessons?

Once the student has obtained a learner's permit. We offer appointments during the day, after school, evenings and on weekends.

What if a student misses a class?

Students need to make up the actual class missed (Module 1-15), as each class covers a distinct curriculum. Contact the office to arrange this.

How does a student register for driver education?

We have three convenient ways to register:

- Register online at ace.colonial.net, or
- In person at CCHS, 500 Walden St in Concord. Our office is located by Dining Commons, or
- Call the Adult & Community Education office at 978-318-1432

How does a student obtain a driver education certificate?

Once a student completes all of the requirements of the driver education program, the driving school will inform the RMV the program has been completed. The RMV will then issue a driver education certificate (no longer mailed out) which can be located on their website, <https://secure.rmv.state.ma.us/DriverEdLookup/driverlookup.aspx>.

When can a student obtain a license?

A student has to have a permit for six months without any infractions, meet all the requirements for driver education, have a Driver Education Certificate processed by the RMV, and pass a road test.

How do I schedule a road test?

Road tests may be scheduled once the driver education certificate is issued. Visit https://secure.rmv.state.ma.us/PrestageAs/PST_IntroAndTermsAndConditions.aspx?Transaction=BookRoadTest to schedule your test online. If you would like a CC ACE instructor to take your son or daughter to the test, contact our office to let us know as soon as the appointment is made. There is a \$100 fee for road tests.

What fees are charged by the RMV?

- Permit test \$30
- Driver education certificate \$15
- Road test appointment \$35
- Driver's license \$50
